

## Buying a Clicker for this Course

A *TurningPoint Response Card RF\** is required to participate in this course. We call these devices “clickers”.

If you already have a clicker from another semester, or if you can borrow one for the whole semester from a friend, that’s fine. All TurningPoint clickers are the same.

If you don’t already have a clicker, you’ll have to buy one from one of the following sources:

- The Bookstore, in the textbook section of the store
  - Toward the end of the Fall and Spring semesters, the Bookstore will offer a buy-back program for the clickers, much as they do with used textbooks
- Online,
  - at <http://store.turningtechnologies.com> and using the code *Bg2Y* get Penn's discounted pricing
  - at [Amazon.com](http://Amazon.com) (direct link: <http://tinyurl.com/ClickersAtPenn>)
  - The price may be lower than at the Bookstore, but shipping costs may be charged.

\*No matter where you buy it, you may buy either the *ResponseCard RF* or the *ResponseCard RF LCD*. They both work with Penn’s systems, but the LCD model has a small screen that confirms your vote.
